Since 1969, residents within the Tanglewood area have enjoyed the use of the 4.6 acre Tanglewood Park. Our children and grandchildren have enjoyed their delightful playground. Little Leaguers have claimed the Park as their home field and tennis buffs, runners and walkers alike have been beneficiaries of this valuable resource. After 40 years, however, the time has come to spruce up our Park and further enhance the community image.

Under the supportive leadership of our City Council Member, Pam Holm, members of the Advisory Council for Tanglewood Park met with Houston Parks & Recreation Department and the Houston Parks Board to come up with a plan for a park renovation campaign. The plan, *A Buzz and A Bark in Tanglewood Park*, as shown in this letter's enclosures, includes a multi-purpose gazebo, an off-leash dog park, powder coated decorative metal fencing to surround our Park on Woodway and Bering, additional benches and picnic tables and needed repairs to the children's playground. The total cost of this renovation is estimated at \$110,740.

Advisory Council Members for Tanglewood Park, The Tanglewood Foundation and several community partners have already contributed \$ 52,250 to *A Buzz and A Bark in Tanglewood Park*. With this support and the City of Houston Park and Recreation Department's commitment to help with some basic installation costs, we are off to a great start.

Now we invite you, as members of our community, to participate in this renovation campaign by making a tax deductible contribution. Giving opportunity suggestions are enclosed within this mailing.

On March 21st from 10:00 am-12:00 am at St. Martin's Episcopal Church Activity Center, 717 Sage Road, the Advisory Council Chairs for Tanglewood Park will be available to all who wish to learn more about these exciting plans and giving opportunities. We welcome and encourage your attendance.
